3. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The prize-giving ceremony will take place at the end of each competition. The eight highest placed riders in each competition will be required to present themselves for the prize-giving ceremony for that competition. This will be confirmed by the competitor information system during each competition.

The owner of the winning horse/pony is invited to the prize giving ceremony for the Grand Prix.

Allocation of prizes will be on the basis of twenty-five percent of participants per competition, with a minimum of five prizes per competition.

4. DEDUCTIONS FROM PRIZE MONEY

Deductions from prize money including government taxes will be made in accordance with Slovenian/EU law. All participants will be provided with an official form showing details of these deductions. All prizes will be a subject to the $15\,\%$ tax according to the Slovenian law.

Prize money will be paid to competitors through a bank allocation, according to the apposite form distributed at the Secretariat and filled in by each of them.

5. INSURANCES

The Owner of any horse which shall cause or occasion any damage or injury whatever shall indemnify and hold harmless the Organisers from and against all legal proceedings, actions, expenses, costs, claims, demands or damages whatsoever arising from any accident or other incident which may occur, and repair any injury which may be so occasioned. Each owner shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any animal exhibited by him, and for the description as given on the official entry form, and shall indemnify and hold harmless CSI-W Lipica 2009 in respect thereof as aforesaid.

Neither the event or any of its officers or servants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for anything that might happen from any cause or circumstances whatsoever to any persons, or Owners, or their servants, or to any animal or article exhibited, or property brought into the showground and its adjoining areas including the stable area and all car parks, or otherwise for anything else in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show in relation thereto. Every owner must have at least one servant (person responsible) in charge of the horse or horses or property exhibited by him.

Vehicles are permitted on the showground, car and horse box parks but only at the owners own risk. No responsibility is accepted for cars or other vehicles

and/or their contents left in the Official Car Park, or elsewhere, before, during or after the event, at any time.

The Event, the Organisers their respective Officers, Servants or Agents shall have no liability for any injury, loss or damage whatsoever and howsoever caused to or suffered by the Athletes, Exhibitors, Invitees or Spectators, their property, servants, agents, horses or other animals. Each Athlete, Exhibitor and Invitee shall indemnify and save harmless the Organisers in respect of any damage or injury of whatever nature and howsoever occasioned to any person or property by any such Competitor or Exhibitor or any horse or other animal which he or she brings or is responsible for bringing to or upon the premises of the Organisers.

4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ENTRY OF HORSES

Every athlete is supplied to deliver all necessary certificates of health for the transport to the event.

a. If the athlete comes from an EU member Country, it is necessary for all horses coming into Slovenia to be accompanied with FEI Passport and with sample of Annex B to Regulations 90/426 of the actual valid form. Horses must be in possession of a negative Coggins test, which must not be older than one year.

b. If the athlete comes from a third country, it is necessary for all horses coming into Slovenia to be accompanied with FEI Passport and a health certificate for registered equidae according to the specimen of annex II of the Commission Decision 92/260 EEC of 10 April 1992 in the current valid issue.

Horses must be in possession of a negative Coggins test, which must not be older than one year.

The original document must be presented, not a copy.

Competitors that need the health certificates for transport of the horses to their destination abroad from an official state veterinarian, must declare it at the show office upon arrival. OC will secure the presence of an official state veterinarian at a certain time frame on one day of the event only. Time will be announced at the show office.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
