She became a candidate international judge in 2002 and has been judging internationally since 2006 in shows across Nordic countries, Russia, Estonia, Canada, France, USA, Spain, Russia, and Italy. Maria was a

member of the ground jury at the 2007 and 2009 World Championships for Young Dressage Horses, last year's European Championships for Young riders, and the FEI World Dressage Challenge series. Mrs. Colliander has competed nationally up to Intermediare I level and has won team gold in national championships 4 times.
